Golf Maintenance Report

Spring is hopefully just around the corner and this is the month that we start certain agronomic practices to prepare the golf course for the coming months. The chemical and fertilizer applications in conjunction with the cultural practices that we will employ over the course of the next few weeks will have a direct impact on the condition of the golf course for the spring and summer months.





In March, we have the first application of our spring pre-emergent scheduled. This application will have a pre-emergent on a fertilizer carrier. When we apply this we will have to be cart path only for a few days to allow time for the fertilizer to break down. This is exactly the same procedure we followed last year.

Also in March we will do our usual greens aerification. Aerification serves several purposes, but three of the most important benefits are relief of soil compaction, better air and gas exchange within the green profile and thatch reduction.
